It's Hot Dog Season!

Confining your dog or cat to the inside of a car, even on a mild day, places your pet in a life-threatening situation.

Animal Control Officers will remove an endangered animal from your vehicle, even if they have to break a window to do it!

Nevada state law aimed at the prevention of cruelty to animals make it illegal for a person to "allow a cat or dog to remain unattended in a parked or standing motor vehicle during a period of extreme heat or cold or in any other manner that endangers the health or safety of the cat or dog."

What to do if you see a distressed animal locked in a hot car.
